- Advanced piano skills preferred

Job Duties (approximately 60% teaching/40% performing)

- Giving music lessons and private and group violin tuition
- Rehearsing/performing concerts with City Chamber Orchestra of Hong Kong

Job Conditions

- Employee must be prepared to work weekends and irregular working hours in different locations (e.g. music school, cultural centre, concert hall etc)
